We are pleased to announce that the 33rd NTPC Senior Indian Round, 22nd NTPC Senior Compound and 46th NTPC Senior Recurve National (M&W) Archery Championship will be held at Shillong, Meghalaya from 11th to 18th November, 2026 (inclusive of both arrival and departure days) under the aegis of Archery Association of Meghalaya.

All the stakeholders are requested to kindly go through the following instructions carefully for your own convenience and to ensure the smooth and successful conduct of the above competitions.

I) Competition fixture and Arrival/Departure of Teams

Senior Nationals will be conducted according to the given schedule –

11st November, 2026	-	Arrival of Teams/Participants/Officials
12th to 17th November, 2026	-	Competition Days for all categories & sections
18th November, 2026	-	Departure of Teams/Participants/Officials

All the participating teams are requested to follow the arrival and departure schedule strictly in order to avoid any inconvenience to participants. Teams reaching Shillong before arrival day or leaving from Shillong after departure day are requested to make their own arrangements. Tentative competition schedule is attached for reference.

II) Eligibility

- i) **Affiliation through AAI Portal** - All the eligible/selected participants including Archers, Coaches, Team Officials and technical Officials for the National Championship are required to be affiliated on the 'Online Affiliation Portal' of the AAI through the AAI website (www.indianarchery.info). The entry of any unaffiliated person would not be entertained.
- ii) **Affiliation Card** – Carrying coloured 'Affiliation Card' (in physical form) to be generated after getting a successful affiliation is a mandatory requirement for taking part in the event.

- iii) **Entry** - Each participating member unit is eligible to field one team of a maximum of four men and one team of a maximum of four women archers in each of the categories (Recurve, Compound, Indian Round events) in the National Championship. No individual or additional entry is allowed in the National Championship. A maximum of one team manager, four male coach, and two female coach are allowed with the team. According to the guidelines issued by the Government of India, it is necessary to have a female coach/official with female athletes.

III) Entry Procedure, Deadlines, Penalty

- i) Entries for the championship must be submitted by **25th October, 2026** via the Tournament Manager. No paper entries will be accepted.
- ii) Entries received between 26th October to 1st November, 2026 will incur a penalty fee of ₹2,000 per member per category. No entries will be accepted after 1st November, 2026. Late entrants must inform AAI in writing, agreeing to the penalty fee. Payment can be made via RTGS to AAI's account or upon arrival.

IV) Accommodation and Food

- i) Free boarding and lodging will be provided to all the participants of the member State Associations/ Associate Members as specified above in clause II. & sub-clause iii.
- ii) The LOC will not be responsible for additional Coaches, Manager, Parents etc.

V) Dress Regulations

All the participants and officials must adhere to the prescribed uniform standards:

- i) Teams should wear coordinated uniforms (T-shirts, track pants, or winter gear) displaying their name and State/Association name on the back.
- ii) Jeans, baggy, or oversized clothing is not permitted.

VI) Flag

The flag of each participating member State Association/Associate Member will be hoisted in the competition field and one will be required for March Past. Therefore, all teams are required to carry two sets of standard-size flags (6 ft X 4 ft) while leaving their destinations.
